
Regional average wages per job are £507 below the national average wages of £30.3k per job.






Job Trends




Millennials

Racial diversity is high in Derby. The national average for an area this size is 38,455 racially diverse people, while there are 56,325 here.








Top Growing Industries





Top Industry Location Quotient








Top Industry GVA








Top Industry Wages


2020 Wages Per Worker






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Location Quotient





Top Occupation Wages


2020 Median Hourly Wages




