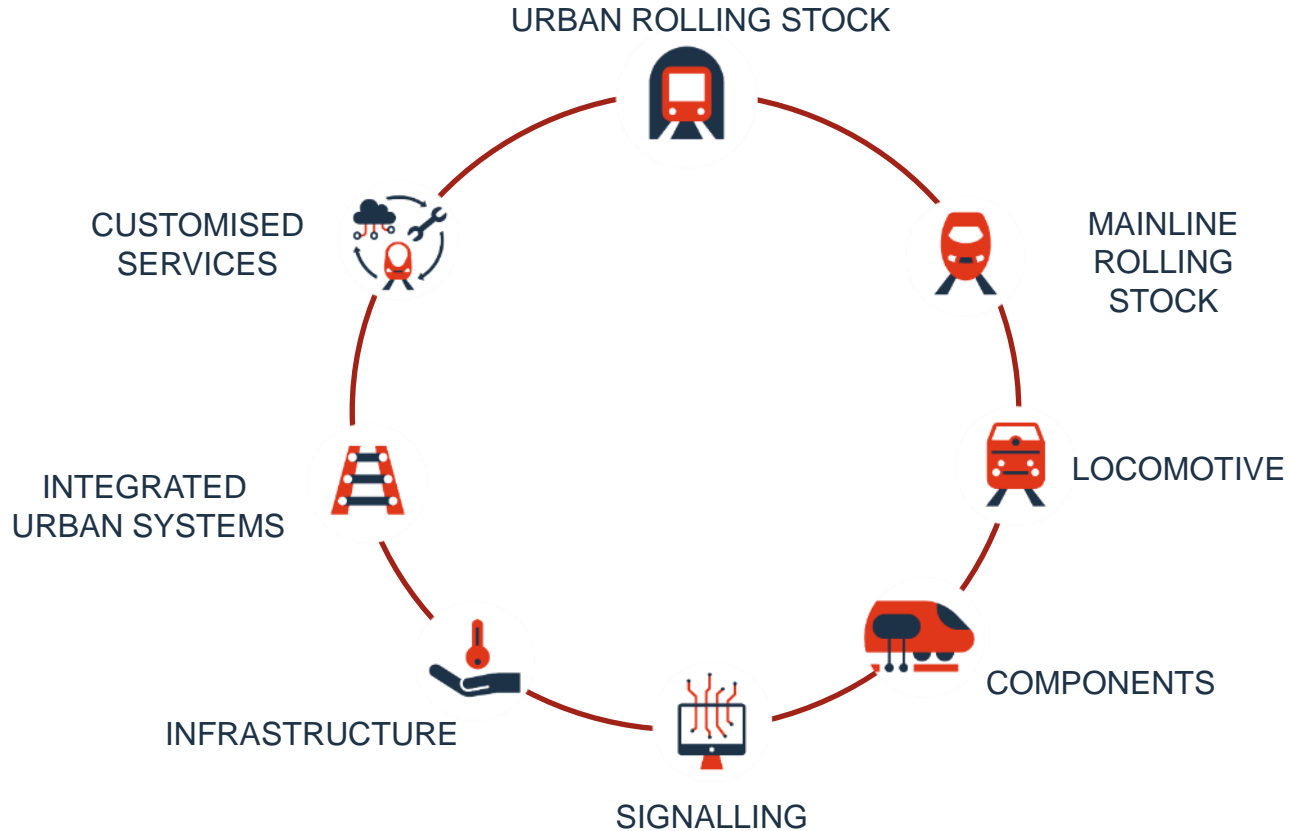

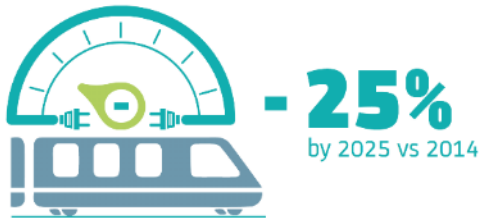

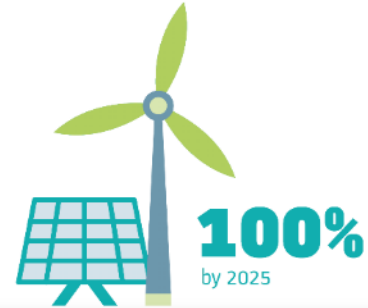

Derby site history

- 1839** Derby Midland Railway Workshops established
- 1876** Derby Carriage Works opened – current site
- 1940-45** Wing construction for the RAF
- 1948** Nationalisation of British Railways
- 1970** Formation of British Rail Engineering Limited (BREL)
- 1989** BREL privatised and sold to consortium (ABB, Trafalgar House and employees)
- 1996** ABB and Daimler-Benz rail activities merged to form ADtranz
- 2001** Bombardier Inc. acquired 100% share of Adtranz Group to form Bombardier Transportation
- 2021** Alstom acquired Bombardier Transportation



Derby Site Overview

- 2000 Employees including:
 - Operations / HSE
 - Engineering
 - Procurement & Supply Chain
 - Project Management
 - Functions – Finance, HR, Sales, Bids, Legal etc.
- 92.000msq production – plant surface 340.000msq
- Car body: receives pre-machined aluminium extrusions which are assembled and welded
- Paint: shot blast and painting with water-based paint.
- Pre-Assembly: Cabs and intermediate ends assembly.
- Final Assembly: 6 AVENTRA production lines + Cairo
- Testing: Engineering validation test centre, internal and external static test and 1.5km dynamic test track (60km/h) fitted with 25Kv AC, 3rd / 4th rail DC

All Apprenticeships require 5 (or more) GCSEs, at grade 5-9 (A*-C), including Maths, English and Science.

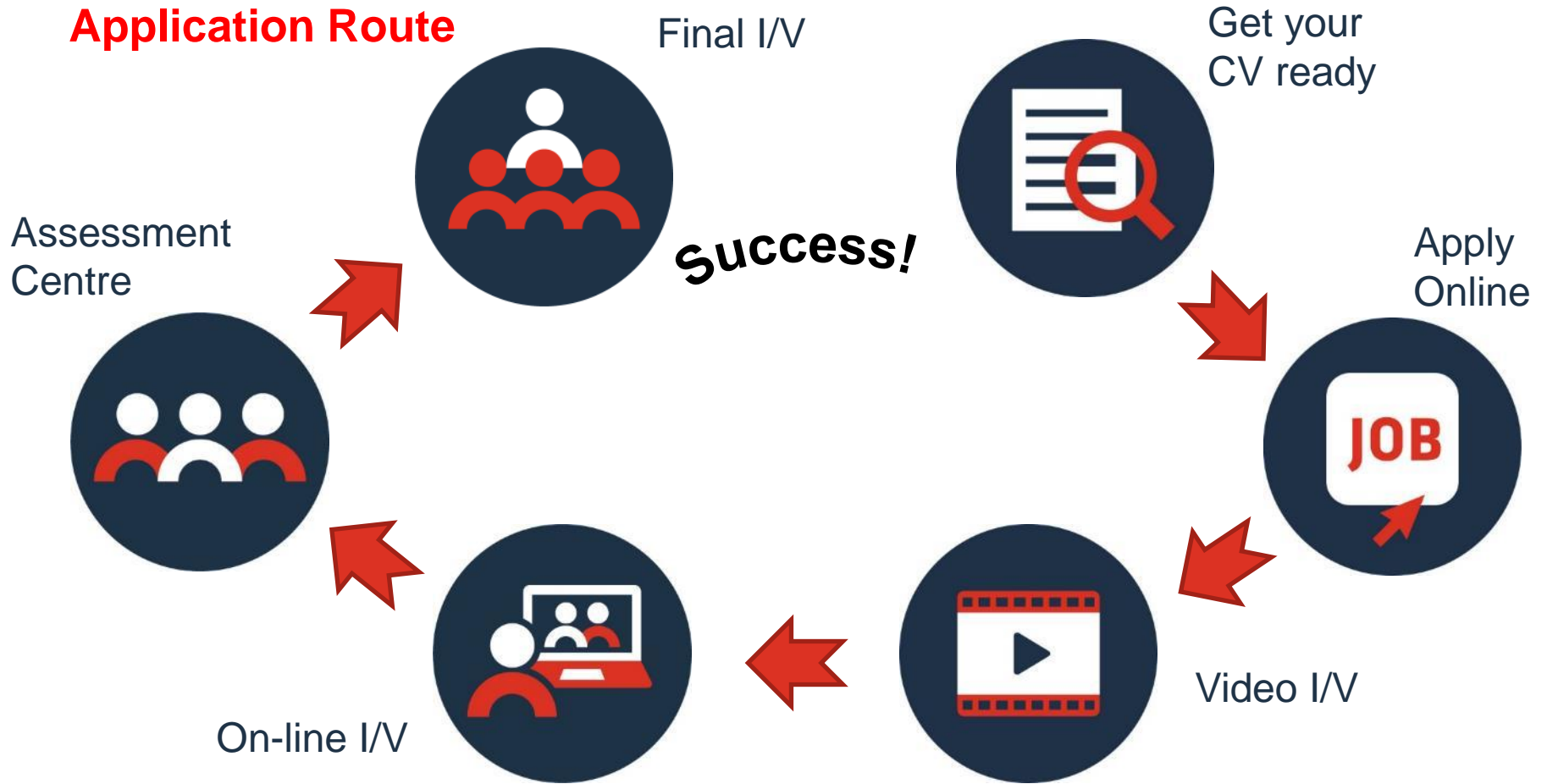
Level 6s also require BTEC or A Levels

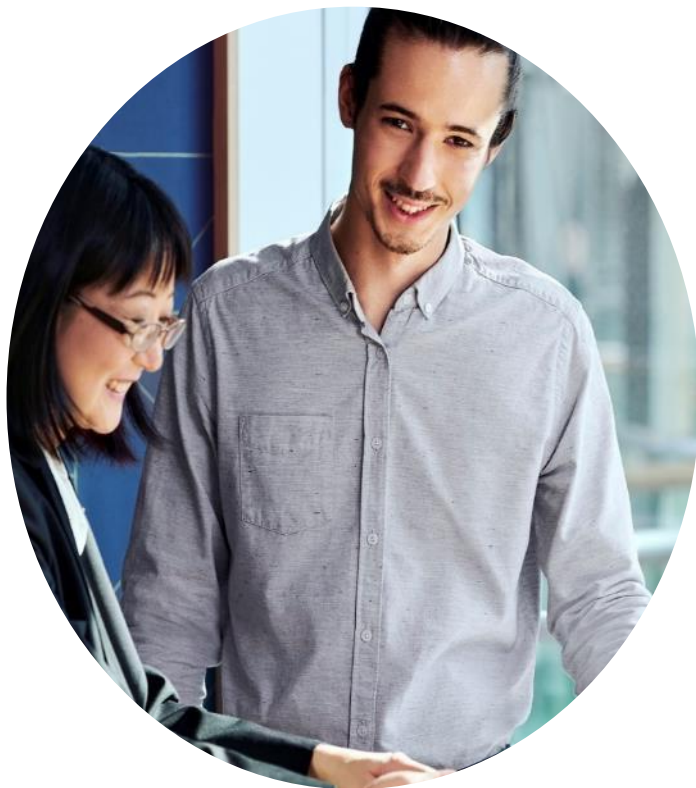
