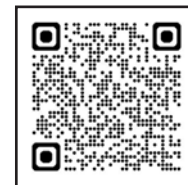

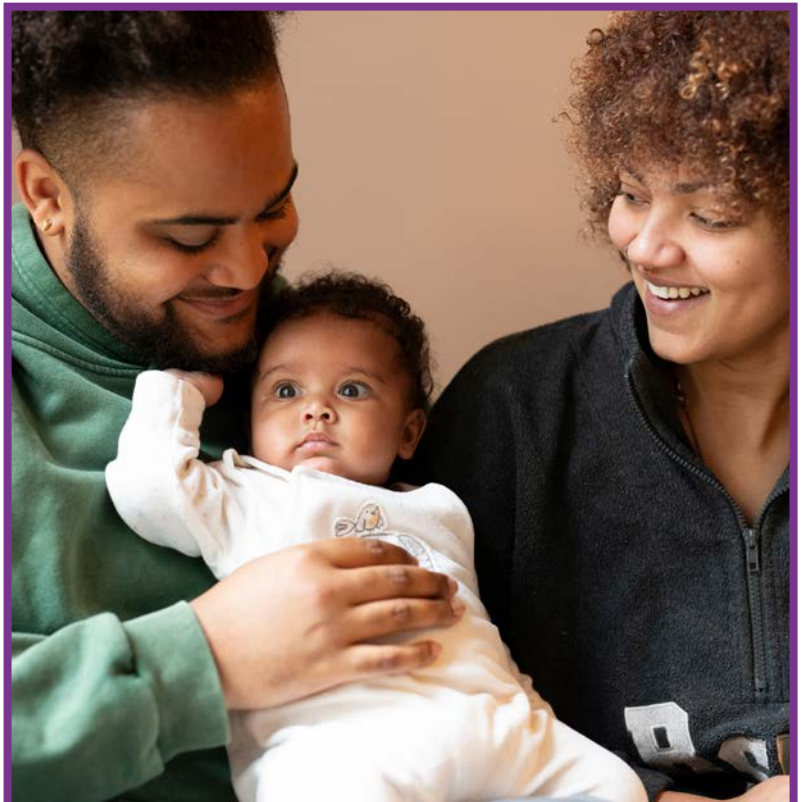

Teenagers and Sleep

Teenagers often undergo huge changes in their sleep patterns, naturally wanting to settle and wake later if they can. Teenagers are not being deliberately awkward however; the influences of hormones, peer pressure, school stresses and screens all make sleep much more challenging. Add additional needs into the mix and it can be hard to know how to help; sleep often becomes a battleground. 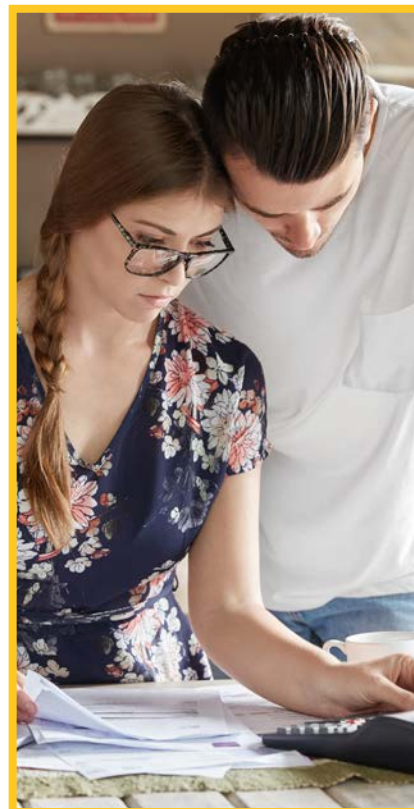

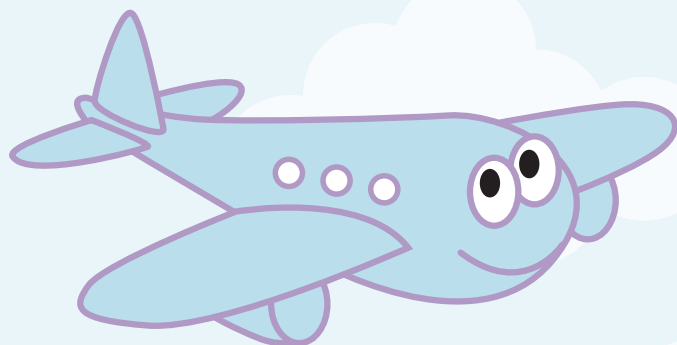
