

Competition rules – Parental Childcare Survey prize draw – June 2021

These are the competition terms and conditions for all our promotions.

1. The promoter for this competition is Derby City Council, Council House, Corporation Street, Derby DE1 2FS (the "Promoter").
2. The competition will run from 9.00am on 28th May 2021 (the "Opening Date") to 5.00pm on 28th June 2021 (the "Closing Date") inclusive.
3. To enter the competition: parents and carers should complete the survey and confirm their personal contact details for the prize draw between the Opening Date and the Closing Date.
4. There is no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
5. Entry to the promotion confirms you have read, understood and agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Eligibility

6. The competition is only open to participants who;
 - a. use formal or informal before or after school childcare or childcare during school holidays within the administrative boundaries of Derby City Council,
 - b. and are aged 18 or over (the "Participants"),
7. Participants may not be eligible if they are:
 - a. employees of the Promoter or its linked companies;
 - b. employees of contractors or any person directly or indirectly involved in the competition;
 - c. members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.
8. In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.
9. There is a limit of one entry to the competition per person.
10. The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.
11. The prize is a £100 prize
12. There is one prize available to be won.
13. Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for the prize. The Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize with a prize of equal value.
14. The prize is non-transferable, non-refundable and non-changeable.
15. The winner will be chosen at random from all eligible entries (on all the related posts) and notified by phone by the Families Information Service Co-ordinator.

16. The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted/traced within ten days after the Closing Date, the winner will forgo the right to claim the prize and the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to a randomly selected replacement winning entry.
17. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding selection.
18. Please allow twenty eight days for delivery of their prize.
19. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the terms of this competition without notice due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.
20. Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

By entering the competition, you agree that any personal information provided by you with the competition entry may be held and used only by the Promoter or its agents and suppliers to administer the competition. In holding any personal information the Promoter will comply with its obligations under all relevant data protection legislation.
22. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude any Participant from participating in the competition.
23. The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel or amend the competition where it becomes necessary to do so. Incomplete, illegible or fraudulent entries may be considered void.
24. The competition is governed by English Law and the English Courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute arising in connection with it.
