

# NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

1. Notice is hereby given that Derby City Council is undertaking an interim review of the polling districts, and polling places within the city and welcome comments from residents, stakeholders, and interested groups.
2. The (Acting) Returning Officer for the Parliamentary constituencies of Derby North, Derby South and Mid-Derbyshire will make comment on the proposals and those representations will be published on the Council's website and be available for inspection at the Council House, Corporation Street, Derby, DE1 2FS.
3. Representations may be made by electors within the authority or within a UK Parliamentary constituency which has any part in the authority. Views from any persons or bodies with expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability would be welcome. Local political parties and City Councillors will also be consulted.
4. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.

Comments and representations may also be submitted in writing to Electoral Services, The Council House, Corporation Street, Derby DE1 2FS. Copies of the on-line questionnaire are available on request.

7. The consultation period runs from 31 October 2022 until 10 January 2023. All representations will be considered, with a final report to be submitted to Council for approval.
