Derby City Children's Early Help and Social Care Our Practice Standards

- 1. The **voice and experience** of children and young people are captured through assessments, plans and visits and this informs the decisions that we make
- 2. A **timely and appropriate response** to contacts and referrals (including transfers between teams)
- 3. All children and young people to have an appropriate **allocated worker**; timescales to be in line with allocation and transfer policies
- 4. All **assessments** (both early help and single) to be completed within agreed timescales, informed by relevant assessment tools, with appropriate management sign off; and consideration should be given to a new single assessment if significant events occur
- 5. All children and young people to have an up to date **chronology** that documents significant events
- 6. All children and young people to have an up to date SMART plan
- 7. All **visits** to be completed, at a minimum, in line with procedures or statutory timescales, and should be in accordance with the child's plan. All visits should meet statutory requirements with regards to where the child is seen
- 8. Effective **direct work** is taking place, in line with the child's plan, which will reduce risks and achieve positive outcomes for the child
- 9. Appropriate responses to **additional factors** that are timely and in line with relevant protocols / strategies i.e. *Pre-birth protocol, Neglect, DV, CSE and Missing , FGM, Forced Marriage, Human Trafficking and Prevent*
- **10. Formal reviews and multi-agency meetings** should take place as necessary and in line with procedures (conferences, CSE meetings, LAC and CiN reviews, network and core group meetings, TAF meetings)
- 11. All staff and managers to make sure **case records / logs** are up to date, and all case recording is relevant
- 12. All staff to have **supervision** in line with the departmental policy that is recorded, reflective and where case focused recorded appropriately on the child's file
