Derby City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order is an experimental order and shall come into force for all purposes on the 20th day of November 2023 and unless renewed, made permanent or revoked shall cease to have effect after the 19th day of May 2025, and may be cited as the Derby City Council (E-scooter Trial) (Moving Vehicle Restrictions) (Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No. 62) (Experimental) Order 2023

Definitions

2. In this Order

- 2.1 The following words shall have the following meanings;

"Principal Order" means the Derby City Council (Moving Vehicle Restrictions) (Conversions to Map Based Schedule) (Consolidation) (Principal) Order 2014 as amended or modified by any subsequent order or any order that consolidates any of those aforesaid orders.

"Subsequent Order" means any order made prior to this Order which amends or modifies the Principal Order including an order giving permanent effect to the restrictions of an Experimental order but does not include an Experimental order.

"Specified Officer" means the Traffic & Transportation Group Manager of the Council or such other officer of the Council as may from time to time be authorised by the Council to determine matters related to the making of road traffic orders under the Act or persons authorised by the said Strategic Director or such other officer.

- 2.2 Except where otherwise stated the definitions, meanings and interpretations in the Principal Order shall equally apply to this Order.

2.3 The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

2.4 The operation of this Order or any provision of it may at any time be modified or suspended by a Specified Officer where it appears to that officer essential for any purpose of section 10(2)(a),(b) or (c) of the Act.

Purpose

3. This Order amends the Principal Order and supersedes any Subsequent Order to the extent that:

3.1 The definitions in Schedule 1 of this Order shall be inserted into Article 2 of the Principal Order.

3.2 Schedule 4 of the Principal Order shall be amended by inserting into the Map those pages listed in Schedule 2 of this Order into the Map in the positions as therein stated, copies of which are attached in Schedule 3 of this Order.

3.3 The Principal Order (including any plans that are inserted into the Map after the making of this Order) shall be read subject to those amendments until such time that the amendments made pursuant to this Order are either amended, revoked or cease to have effect.

SCHEDULE 1

ARTICLE TO BE INSERTED

The following definitions shall be inserted in Article 2 with the text set out below:

"E-scooter" means an electric scooter as defined under Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 Schedule 1 as amended by The Electric Scooter Trials and Traffic Signs (Coronavirus) Regulations and General Directions 2020 being used in a trial.

"trial" means for the purpose of an electric scooter being used in a trial shall have the meaning attributed to it pursuant to The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations 2002 as amended by paragraph 2(3)(b) of The Electric Scooter Trials and Traffic Signs (Coronavirus) Regulations and General Directions 2020.

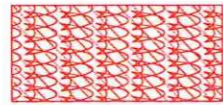

Prohibition or Restriction of Movement during Operative Periods

Prohibition of driving of motor vehicles relating to events at Derby County's Football Stadium where the Operative Period may be determined by a Police Constable subject to the following provisos, exemptions 1:

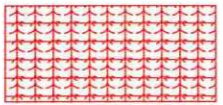
- a. Signs of the regulations are on display
- b. Operative Period shall be a continuous period invoked 45 minutes before the scheduled start of the event for a period ending 5 minutes after the scheduled start of the event
- c. Operative Period shall be a continuous period starting 5 minutes before the scheduled end of the event for 30 minutes

One way for motor vehicles relating to events at Derby County's Football Stadium where the Operative Period may be determined by a Police Constable subject to following provisos, exemptions 1.

- a. Operative Period shall be continuous period not exceeding 45 minutes duration
- b. Operative Period shall commence no more than 15 minutes prior to the end of an event

Prohibition of driving of motor vehicles relating to events at Derby County's Football Stadium where the Operative Period may be determined by a Police Constable subject to the following provisos, exemptions 1:

- a. Signs of the regulations are on display
- b. Operative Period shall be a continuous period not exceeding 35 minutes duration
- c. Operative Period to commence no more than 5 minutes prior to the anticipated end of the event

Prohibition of driving of vehicles where Operative Period may be determined by a Police Constable subject to the following provisos, exemptions 1,4:

- a. Operative Period shall be a continuous period between the hours of midnight and 4am the following day on any Friday, Saturday, Sunday preceeding a Bank Holiday / Public Holiday on the Monday, Christmas Eve, Boxing Day or New Year's Eve.

Moving Vehicle Restriction

Key to Exemptions

1. General Exemption

- a. A vehicle being used in the case of an emergency by the Fire, Ambulance or Police Services.
- b. A vehicle if it cannot be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in conjunction with any of the following operations, namely:
 - i. building, engineering or demolition operations;
 - ii. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - iii. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - iv. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to such length of road or any sewer or any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - v. in the service of a Local Authority, Water Company or statutory undertaker in pursuance of its statutory powers or duties;
 - vi. for the carrying out of works on the lengths of road or adjacent premises, where the vehicle is required for the delivery or collection of materials or goods which cannot reasonably be carried by hand: or
 - vii. being used for the purposes of delivering or collecting postal packages as defined in section 125 Postal Services Act 2000.

Specific Exemptions

2. Subject to any specific label on the Map, a vehicle gaining access and egress to and from specified premises or locations as indicated on the map, during times indicated on the Map and in accordance with the requirements and subject to fronting the said roads or as specified on the map (time purpose restriction and other restriction permits) other than gaining access to or egress from premises accessible only from said road.
3. A vehicle being used in the course of a funeral or wedding procession.
4. During the Operative Period of the prohibition of vehicles in The Strand vehicles gaining access for the delivery of goods or items from premises in The Strand, St. James Street, Corn Market or The Wardwick are exempt from Victoria Street and Albert Street (bus lanes & prohibitions of driving) restrictions.
5. Except for access for Goods Vehicles, access to off street premises, disabled parking bays, taxi rank and for community transport and public service vehicles.

6. A vehicle designed or adapted for the conveyance of bullion and similar securities, used in the course of deliveries

7. Pedal cycles

- 7a. Electric scooter (E-scooter) as defined in The Electric Scooter Trials and Traffic Signs (Coronavirus) Regulations and General Directions 2020 (or as otherwise amended) hired from a company authorised by the Department for Transport to operate electric scooters within the City of Derby.

Area Environmental Weight Limits Exemptions

8. A vehicle:
 - a. being used for the tuition or tests pursuant to Part III of the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1977
 - b. in excess of 16'9" high and using the high load route via
 - i. Duffield Road and Broadway to avoid that section of the A38 between the Kedleston Road flyover and the Duffield Road roundabout
 - ii. to proceed along Uttoxeter Road (B5020) from its junction with the Royal Derby Hospital roundabout to its junction with the roundabout at Etwall Road / Ladybank Road junction.
