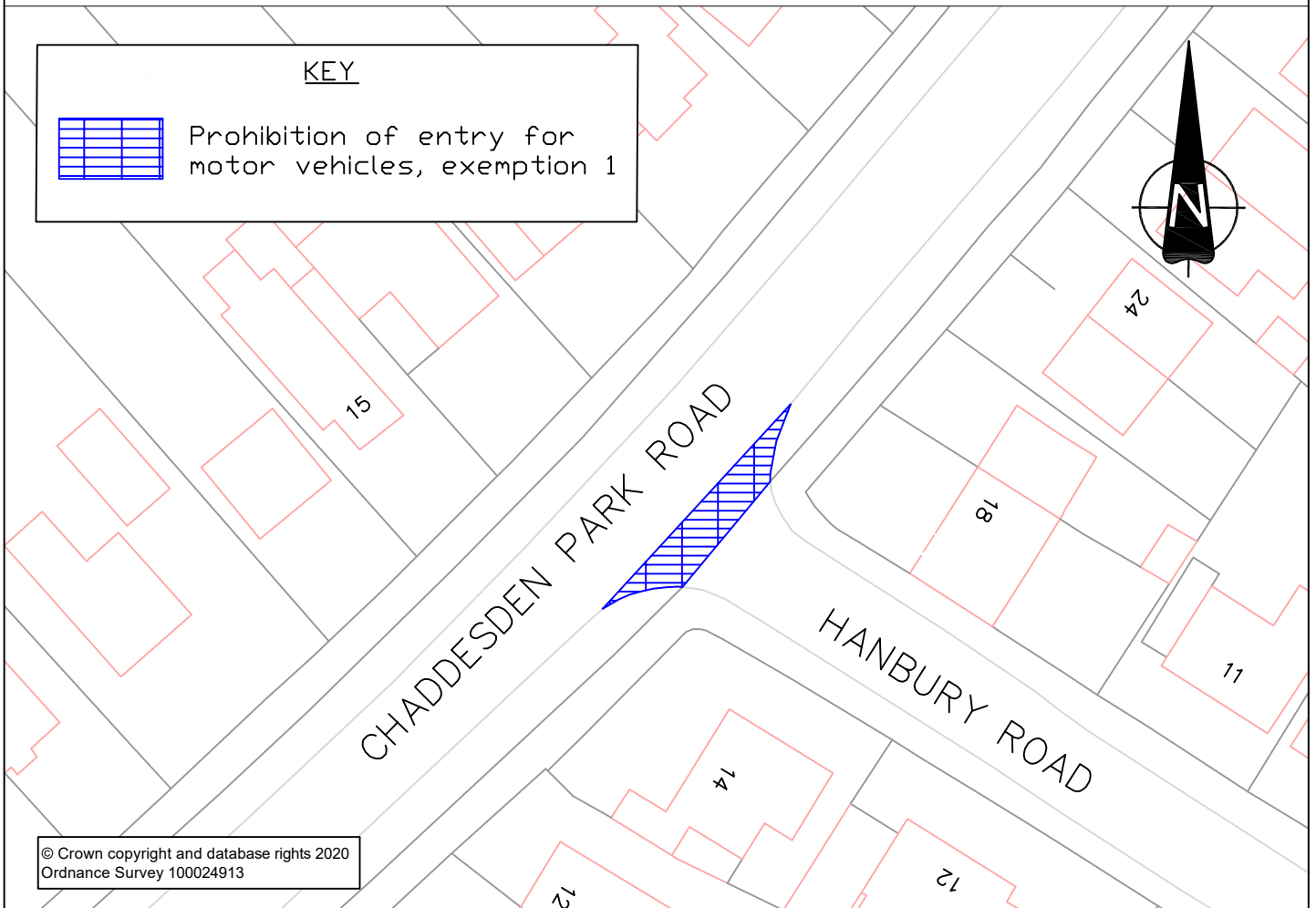


Derby City Council (Hanbury Road) (Moving Vehicle Restrictions) (Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No.43) (Experimental) Order 2021

DERBY CITY COUNCIL made this Experimental Order on the 24th day of March 2022, which will become effective from the 4th day of April 2022 for a period of 18 months, under Sections 1, 2, 4, and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Road Traffic Act 1991 the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police:

The purpose of the Experimental Order will be to bring in to effect the restriction shown on the map below

The restriction is subject to the standard applicable exemptions.
